- **Pediatric Moderna** and **Pediatric Pfizer** have been *AUTHORIZED* for use in children 6months of age and older.
- Adolescent Pfizer (12-15 years old) has been FULLY APPROVED by the FDA.

Cavalier County Health District recommends all individuals 6 months of age and older receive an influenza vaccine this season to prevent getting the flu. Influenza is an illness characterized by fever, body aches, cough and sore throat, not the "stomach flu" people often think of. New 988 Suicide & Crisis Lifeline

In 2020, the U.S. had one death by suicide every 11 minutes. Suicide is a leading cause of death for people aged 10-34 years. In response to this tragic reality, in 2020, Congress designated the new 988 dialing code to be operated through the existing National Suicide Prevention Lifeline. BUZZED DRIVING IS DRUNK DRIVING

Despite the fact that it's illegal to drive drunk, one person was killed every 52 minutes in a drunk driving crash on our nation's roads in 2019. That's a total of 10,142 people who died in alcoholimpaired driving crashes in one year. Even a small amount of alcohol can affect a person quickly; for example, a blood alcohol concentration of .02 can affect someone's ability to perform two tasks at one time.

Be Responsible: Have a Plan

Your life and the lives of others on the road are at risk every time a driver gets behind the wheel after drinking. Here are a few tips to stay safe:

- •Before drinking, choose a designated driver, or schedule a ride-share.
- •If you are hosting a party where there's alcohol, offer non-alcoholic drink options and make sure all guests leave with a sober driver.
- •Always wear your seat belt it's the best defense against drunk drivers.
- •If you see a drunk driver on the road, safely pull over and call law enforcement or use NDTip to submit an anonymous tip to law enforcement.

Health Fair

Langdon Prairie Health held a Health Fair & Blood Drive on June 21, 2022. There were a total of 22 vendors, 55 blood donors of which 45 were able to donate, and 120-140 attendees. Cavalier County Health District had a booth educating community members on substance use and safe medication disposal as well as a booth aimed at bringing awareness to how much sugar may be in what we are drinking. It was an educational day that Cavalier County Health District was proud to be a part of.



Youth Safety Day

Progressive Agriculture Safety Day, held on June 7, drew 55 children in grades 2-6 from Cavalier County for a half-day session on how to take responsibility for their own safety and health. According to Steph Welsh with Cavalier County Health District, children learned how to identify safety hazards and to make safer and healthier decisions.

Hands-on experiences led by local community members and regional volunteers taught participants about life-long safety lessons. Tobacco Tax

North Dakota's tax on cigarettes is **44 cents per pack** of 20 cigarettes. Cigar and pipe tobacco are taxed at 28% of the wholesale price. North Dakota is ranked **49th lowest** in the nation for tobacco tax and hasn't raised their tobacco tax since 1993. Increasing the price of tobacco through taxes is a proven-effective way to help people quit and keep youth from ever starting to use tobacco.
