# It's not too late to get a FLU Shot!

CDC recommends a yearly flu vaccine for everyone 6 months of age and older as the first and most important step in protecting against this serious disease. While there are many different flu viruses, the seasonal flu vaccine is designed to protect against the top three flu virus strains that research indicates will cause the most illness during the current flu season.

If you are an uninsured adult, you may be eligible to receive **FREE** vaccines including Flu, Covid, Tetanus, and/or Pneumonia vaccines so don't let the worry of cost stop you from protecting yourself and your family.

So be sure to get your flu shot this year and stay healthy.

Vaccines being offered include: Flu, Covid-19, Pneumonia, Shingles, RSV, and Tdap—tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis (whooping cough)


