PREGNANCY

BEFORE getting pregnant, make sure you are up to date on MMR vaccination.

DURING pregnancy, it's important to get Flu, Tdap, COVID-19, and RSV vaccinations.

AFTER the birth of your baby, if you haven't received your Tdap or COVID-19 shots you should get vaccinated right away. Ensure those around you and your baby are also vaccinated for FLU, COVID-19, and Tdap.

QPR Suicide Prevention Training:

Question, Persuade, Refer training will alert you to the signs (direct or coded) that people often signal before attempting suicide. It will give you simple steps and resources to help you make a positive intervention, including what to look for and what to say once signs are present.

CALM Suicide Prevention Training:

Counseling on Access to Lethal Means (CALM) focuses on how to reduce access to the methods people use to die by suicide. *QPR training is a pre-requisite for CALM training.

SAFETY Planning for Suicide Prevention Training:

A safety plan is a personalized, pre-determined, and prioritized written list of coping strategies and sources of support that people can use before and during suicidal crises. This session discusses the rationale for safety planning, practical ideas for use with clients, and a downloadable, free app to utilize in client care.
