Measles is in North Dakota-What You Need to Know

The United States is currently experiencing a measles outbreak, with confirmed cases in North Dakota. Health officials are urging residents to stay informed, check their vaccination status, and take precautions to prevent further spread.

MEASLES SYMPTOMS TYPICALLY INCLUDE

- High fever (may spike to more than 104° F)
- Cough
- Runny nose
- Red, watery eyes
- Rash breaks out 3-5 days after symptoms begin

What to do if you think you or your child has measles

- Everyone in the house should stay home to not get your neighbors or people outside of your home sick.
- Call a doctor or hospital Before seeking care if you are having any of the above symptoms. They will give you instructions.

MMR vaccination is the best way to prevent measles

MMR vaccine is typically given between 12 and 15 months of age and a booster dose is given after the age of 4. Early vaccination is recommended for those travelling to places with active measles outbreaks.

COMPLICATIONS

- Ear infections: 1 in 10 children
- Pneumonia:1 in 20 children
- Brain swelling:1 in 1,000 children
- Hospitalization: 1 in 5 unvaccinated people
- Death: 1-3 of every 1,000 children

LONG-TERM COMPLICATIONS

>Immune amnesia:

Measles can wipe out immune memory, making you vulnerable to other infections.

brain disease that can develop 7–11 years after measles, especially in children infected before age two.
